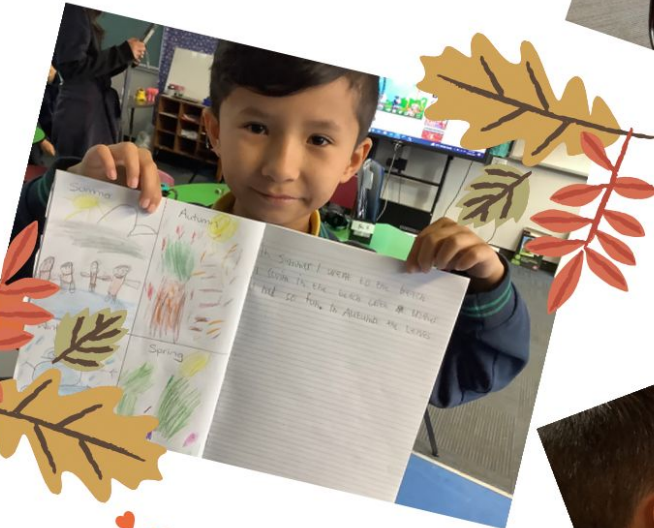
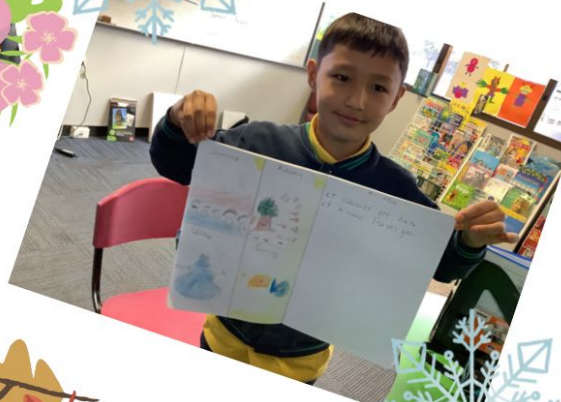


## Writing About the 4 Seasons of the Year

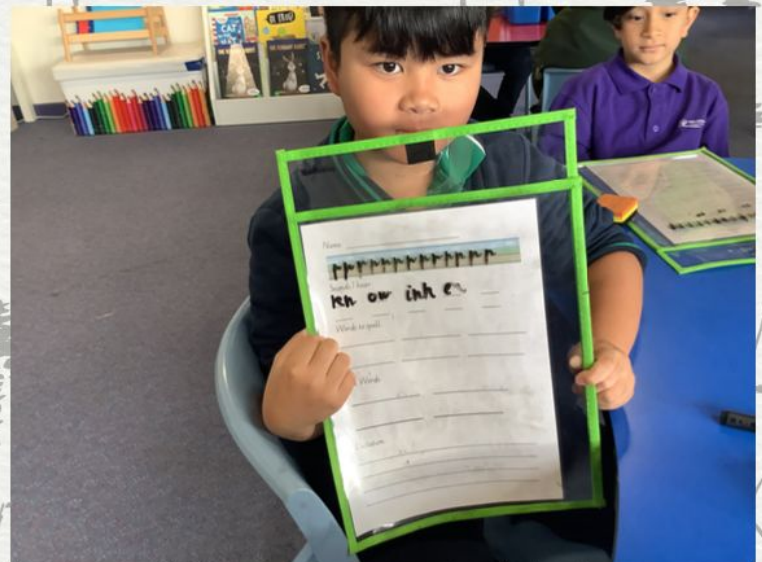
