Hunt around your home looking for things that start with the letter 't.' For example: towel starts with a 't.'

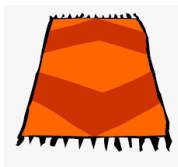


Draw a picture of each item that you find that begins with the letter 't' and upload a photo of your picture to your seesaw journal.

Do you get confused sometimes between 'm' and 'n'? Look at the picture, say the word and listen carefully to the sounds you hear. Then use finger spelling to help you spell these words.

Play a game of 'I Spy' with a family member. Choose an object. Give a clue about the object along with a word that rhymes with it.



For example: I spy with my little eye, something you walk on that rhymes with bug!
