Get a magazine, newspaper or 'junk mail' from your letter box. Cut out all of the sight words that you can read.



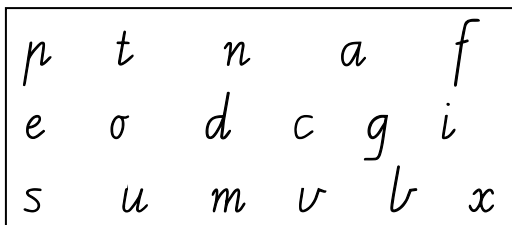
Glue them onto a piece of paper. Read the words and record your reading on Seesaw.

Scoring: 3 letter word – 1 point
4 letter word – 2 points
5 letters or more – 5 points

-ED: Past Tense

When we add '- ed' to the end of a word it makes it past tense (It has already happened) For example: walk – walked. '-ED' can make three different sounds /t/ at the end of 'helped', /d/ at the end of 'drilled' and /ed/ at the end of 'rented' Make three long lists of words that have the 'ed' ending.
