

Year 2 Literacy Grid - Focus: Reading & Fluency


-ED: Past Tense

When we add '-ed' to the end of a word it makes it past tense (It has already happened) For example: walk – walked. 'ED' can make three different sounds /t/ at the end of 'helped', /d/ at the end of 'drilled' and /ed/ at the end of 'rented' Make three long lists of words that have the 'ed' ending.

/t/	/d/	/ed/
helped	drilled	rented
