The Performing Arts Centre was built as a joint project with the Hampton Park Secondary College and was constructed on their site directly opposite River Gum Primary School.

The River Gum Performing Arts Centre or 'The PAC' as we call it, has the capacity to seat 497 people. It is used on a daily basis within the schools by the drama, music and multi-media departments as well as for school assemblies.

Did you know that the centre is available for hire by anyone in our community?

We have had visitors who have used the centre for everything from school productions, dance performances to meetings, and even cinema evenings.

With seating for 497 people, a professional sound system, theatre lighting system as well as screen and projection equipment we can cater for almost anything!

Speaking of catering, there is also a kitchen/canteen area in the main foyer which you can also take advantage of.

Our fold up theatre style seating is comfortable and raked to ensure that everyone gets an unobstructed view of the action. The theatre was designed with excellent acoustics so all of your guests can enjoy the show and in air conditioned comfort.



When the PAC was built the decision was made to provide for the future so a digital Yamaha LS9 32 channel sound desk was chosen. The entire building was professionally 'wired for sound' with stage boxes and patch bays throughout the building. We have a full compliment of vocal, instrument and wireless microphones to cater for almost any performance.

The stage dimensions are 15m wide and 10m deep. We have a motorised main curtain and two hand draw black baffle curtains, one which divides the stage in two across the middle. The second draws in front of the white cyc. curtain.



Our Lighting desk is 96 channel programmable Phillips Strand 200. It is connected to 48 channel dimmer racks with a compliment of stage lighting as well as a spotlight. A motorised screen lowers at the front of the stage and a high resolution projector can display computer and video images.
